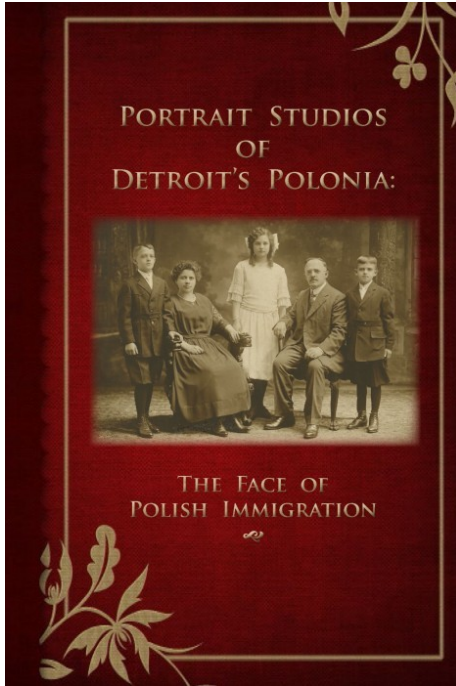


Portrait Studios of Detroit's Polonia: The Face of Polish Immigration
